



The Lane Preserve is a 270-acre preserve with 2.5 miles of trail with panoramic views of the forest, river and grassland. Located in Gladwin County, the preserve also features an old oak grove and access to the Cedar River where you'll find brown trout and other aquatic life.

The Lane Preserve is managed in partnership with Leon P. Martuch Chapter of Trout Unlimited.
